I AM MINISTRIES

Principle, truth and values; foundations to live by are important in life. Sometimes we may find them inconvenient, or unwanted, but in the end they keep us safe.

Austin O'Malley once said, "Men who think it permissible to tell white lies soon grow colorblind." St. Augustine also said,

"When regard for the truth has been broken down or even slightly weakened, all principle will remain in doubt." A.W. Tozer said, "The heart that fails to cultivate truth and root out error will be a theological wilderness."

In Luke 14, we discover a truth to live by. In verses 7-11, we find we are instructed to put others first. Verses 8-11 tell us "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled and everyone who humbles himself will be exalted." I believe this principle work this way. Seek the position or place nobody else wants and receive the position or place everybody wants. So often in life we find ourselves either at home or at work just wanting to be noticed or appreciated, and yet our work as Christians is not to seek our own self-interests, but the interests of others and then we will find we are rewarded. When you stop to think about it, to be able to live out the Great Commission, to preach the Gospel and bring the lost to Christ, we really need to be able to put others first before our own security and comfort. It's not easy to be serious about reaching the lost. We need to place them as #1 priority over ourselves. Christ did this at the cross for us. He lay down his life and suffered a death on a cross. He did this for us at this resurrection as well. He called on us in the great Commission to do the same. We need to put ourselves in a position where we can lead others to Christ and help the lost souls of this world find their way home. It's a position many do not want, but in the end we will find ourselves in a position everybody wants to be in.

A couple of years ago, I met a man who is now a Minister of the Gospel. He shared the story of his conversion with me. He had given his life to Christ at an evangelistic rally in New Foundland. Then he told me I was the evangelist. The truth is I almost did not show up that day. I was tired and pretty much exhausted from some of the things going on is our church. But, out of obedience I went. I had to put the conversion of the lost over my need to rest. The reward was to bring a lost soul to Christ who would himself share the Gospel with others. What a privilege and joy to bring others to Christ. Putting them first so God may touch a heart and change a life. Let us then be like those who seek a position nobody wants, a position where we can be strategically used for the work of the Kingdom. What position has God put you in today? Are you prepared to use it for His glory?
